Here is a list of French language challenges that you could have fun with in the summer holidays. You can pick which ones you would like to do. Show us in September what you complete!

- Research a famous French person from history or today. Can you create a short biography about them?
- Practise counting to 10 or to 100 (or more)! Find the numbers online!
- Find out about the currency used in France. How is it different to the currency used here?
- Plan a menu for a French meal. Could you cook / eat some of the items on your menu?
- Research the wild animals that can be found in France.
- Use plastic straws to create a model of the Eiffel Tower. Take a photo!
- Learn about famous French artists. Can you try to create some of your own artwork in a similar style? Or do a collage of pictures and information about an artist you like?
- Draw a picture of an artist's palette and label different colours using their French names.
- Can you learn the lyrics to a French song?
- Use a blank outline map of France to plot the location of French cities and places of interest.
- Research the current weather in France. Can you record a weather forecast?
- Find some facts about France and used them to make a fact file.
- Plan a trip to France. How will you get there? How long is the journey?
- Create a tour guide for people who are planning to visit France.
- Find out the countries that share a border with France.
- Create a timeline showing some of the key events in French history.
- Investigate the festivals and celebrations that take place in France.
- Rehearse a simple French conversation. Can you perform / record this?
- Make a French dictionary to teach others some French words.
