

## English Language & English Literature GCSE

### YEAR 1

#### **Paper 1 Creative Responses: Section A Reading. Section B Writing**

Students will read a range of stimulating and contemporary novels, focusing on the writer's use of language and structure. Students will also develop the ability to evaluate the writer's craft and its effect on audience.

#### **Paper 2, Viewpoint: Section A Reading. Section B Writing**

Students will use AQA approved text books to develop Paper 2 skills:
