

**MODULES/UNITS**

YEAR 10 Advanced Skills, Food Science and Practice Controlled Assessment.

In this year a more in depth knowledge of food science will be developed, to include interactions of different foods and sources of different ingredients. In the practical lessons there will be opportunity to develop advanced food preparation techniques. Towards the end of the year practice controlled assessment tasks will be completed in preparation in year 10.

YEAR 11 Controlled Assessment and Exam Practice.

Year 11 will consist mainly of controlled assessment and exam practice. The first piece of controlled assessment will start in September based on a practical investigation of a food science problem. The second piece of controlled assessment will start in November and will be planning a three course meal for a specific theme, this will be followed by a three hour practical exam which will take place in February. After the completion of this task exam practice will be undertaken for the final written exam.
