YEAR 10 NUTRITION, FOOD SCIENCE, ETHICAL ISSUES, FOOD SKILLS.

In this scheme the theory and science of nutrition is explored and all the different nutrients are looked at individually. We will also look at how ingredients work and ethical issues associated with food. In the double lesson there is development of many higher practical skills and the functions of different ingredients are discussed.

YEAR 11 CONTROLLED ASSESSMENT AND EXAM PRACTICE.

Year 11 will consist mainly of controlled assessment and exam practice. The first piece of controlled assessment will start in September based on a practical investigation of a food science problem. The second piece of controlled assessment will start in November and will be planning a three course meal for a specific theme, this will be followed by a three hour practical exam which will take place in February. After the completion of this task exam practice will be undertaken for the final written exam.
